

## Hungerford Round Table Raises £4,000 for Cancer Research with Epic Cycle Ride

On 3<sup>rd</sup> July 2010 Keith Mayes completed a 1,059 mile solo cycle route from Land's End to John O' Groats. The trip which took 14 days required cycling an average of 75 miles a day, carrying all clothes, tools, supplies and equipment. Keith commented, "the early days were gruelling, especially in Cornwall and Devon, but the terrain eventually calmed down and I got into the swing of things. Reaching the final signpost at JOG was a great feeling."
